
Dia Meters Lesson #4: Odd ostinato in 3/16

1. Play solo against odd ostinato in 3/16:

The $3/16^{th}$ ostinato is played with one limb, against one, two or three other limbs simultaneously. Practice easy beats at first in order to improvise against the 3/16 ostinato.

Play the 3/16 ostinato with one hand (or foot):




Against the next even patterns (EPs 1-4) – in the other hand or feet: (Diameters page 67)



Example with EP3 (Diameters 68 - 70) - cd - 38)




Transpose this exercise into horizontal, vertical and diagonal combinations using hands and feet.



Other options:

3/16 ostinato in the bassdrum \leftrightarrow EP's played with both hands on floor & snaredrum; 3/16 ostinato on the hihat (LH) \leftrightarrow EP alternates between bassdrum & snare drum

2. Play the 3/16 ostinato against a single paradiddle



(Vertical paradiddle alternating between floor & bass + ostinato on the snare (LH) - Dia Meters page 70)
